# What's New?

#### **New Features**

This release of the Fastmarkets Dashboard includes the introduction of Customized Newsletters which will be published in PDF and HTML email formats on a daily and weekly basis based on the Dashboard Market page newsletter options you select.

Customized Newsletters have been designed for customers who wish to receive a digest via email / pdf of prices and/or news depending on their subscription or have previously received the Metal Bulletin or AMM Daily pdf's.

The newsletters are accessible to you based on your subscription.


- Newsletters containing both prices and news will require both a price and news package subscription
- Newsletters that contains prices from multiple packages will require a subscription to all those price packages
- Newsletters that contain news from multiple news packages will require access to at least one of those news packages
- If you subscribe to a news only package you will only be able to access news only newsletters
- If you subscribe to a prices only subscription you will only be able to access prices only newsletters

#### **How to access newsletters?**


1. Newsletter Center

Clicking on the NEWSLETTERS button in the left sidebar will open the Newsletters area within the dashboard. This table has two tabs displayed at the top. Clicking on the 'All newsletters tab' shows all available newsletters. Clicking on a group (e.g. Base metals) will display all relevant newsletters within that group.






Each row (e.g. Aluminium P1020) represents a customized newsletter. By clicking on 'Latest daily" or 'Latest weekly', you are able to download the latest version of that newsletter.



#### 2. Market pages

Newsletters can also be accessed from the market page directly. Clicking on the Newsletter button at the top right hand corner, a dropdown menu opens where you can download the latest daily or weekly versions.






#### How to set up newsletters to be delivered via email?

If you want to receive newsletters via email, you can set this up through the dashboard.

In the Newsletter center, tick the 'Daily emails' or 'Weekly emails' boxes next to the relevant newsletter that you want to receive.

Alternatively, go to the market page, select the Newsletter button and tick the 'Daily emails' or 'Weekly emails' boxes in the dropdown.

If you want to review what newsletters you have selected, go to the Newsletter center and select the 'Active Newsletters' tab. If you no longer want to receive a newsletter, you can un-tick the box.




#### What does the email newsletter contain?

The email will contain the headline and a summary of the articles plus the pricing tables in that newsletter. When you click on a headline, it will open the full article in the dashboard. When you click on a symbol within a price table, it will open the price details in the dashboard.



Within the email you will find an 'Open PDF newsletter' button which allows you to download the PDF version of the newsletter. Please note you have to be a logged-in Fastmarkets dashboard user to be able to download PDF newsletters.

## GLOBAL NICKEL WRAP: US briquette premium rises in flurry of spot trade

The US nickel briquette premium continued to ascend in the week to Tuesday October 20 amid increased spot business at higher levels while lackluster appetites kept all other regional premiums stable over the

- · Spot deals for US briquettes enlivened at higher levels, pushing the premium up from historic lows hit in September.
- Sustained lack of arbitrage opportunities in China kept premiums there unchanged.
- · European market held firm at already-low levels after stainless steel consumers moved prices lower in early October.

Despite market consensus that Chinese economic recovery is driving upward price momentum in nickel prices on both the London Metal Exchange and Shanghai Futures Exchange, this on-exchange activity did not manifest in

The LME three-month nickel price closed up 2.1% on the previous day's \$15,684 per tonne kerb at \$16,023 on October 20.

LME nickel futures are now trading at their highest since October 2019 with attitudes to the preferential electric vehicle metal increasingly bullish.


And while nickel stocks in Shanghai Futures Exchange-listed warehouses totaled rose by 667 tonnes to 29,832 tonnes on October 16, they pale into comparison to LME nickel inventory, which is currently 237,366 tonnes.


While the arbitrage window between the two exchanges remains closed, optimism for higher premiums remains thin on the ground.

Fastmarkets assessed the nickel, min 99.8%, full plate premium, cif Shanghai












Similarly, the 'Key steel coil prices' section of the newsletter corresponds to the 'Key steel coil prices' widget in the market page. Please note that price tables in the newsletter have fixed fields and these fields may differ to what is displayed in the market page.







### **How is the Weekly newsletter constructed?**

The weekly newsletter follows a similar logic to the daily newsletter with the following differences.

- In Weekly newsletters, there is no separate Top Stories section.
- The news list section of the newsletter will display Top Stories only.
