New Features

This release of the Fastmarkets Dashboard includes new functionality and features including:


- New content access base metals bonded stocks and chrome ore and manganese ore inventories via the 'Data reports' widget
- New content this release includes short term forecast pricing for Steel, Scrap and Aluminium/Alumina. Please note forecast pricing is an add-on service to your existing price packages. To find out more click here

- 'Recommended news lists' when adding a news widget, for example 'Base metals'.

Access new bonded stocks and inventory data via the Data Reports widget

The base metals bonded stocks and chrome ore and manganese ore inventories can be accessed via the Add Widget button using the Data reports widget. The bonded stocks are available to customers with base metals prices included in their subscription and the chrome ore and manganese ore inventories are available to those with ores and alloys prices.







Select the option Data Reports (this previously was named Exchange data reports):






Choose an existing workspace or create a new workspace to add the widget to:








Select an option from the "Report type" dropdown menu to view the data:



You can also choose to display data for previous dates: each report view presents the data based on what is the most recent update of the data against that date. The available dates will be highlighted in white:





New Short Term Forecast content


Fastmarkets have been providing research analytics for over 30 years and our forecasts are built on a robust methodology which will enable you to plan purchasing or manage inventories; guiding your next decision or negotiation whether you are buying, trading or hedging.

Fastmarkets Short Term Forecasts will allow you to view forecast prices in your current workspace alongside past history in your existing Dashboard charts and quickly access forecast summaries as well as navigate to full research from our analyst team. Understand why prices are at current or past levels as well as a view of how they will develop over the coming months.

Access to short term forecast content is available as an add on to your existing Fastmarkets data license.

Fastmarkets forecasts prices are published monthly for the current and following year for example e.g. in October 2021 – prices are forecasted to the end of 2022. Corresponding commentary will update throughout the month as markets move.

Price forecasts can be plotted alongside existing Fastmarkets published assessments in a Price Chart widget so you can understand the historic assessment price trend and view the forecasted price direction together in one chart. Each dashed line to the right of the price history represents a monthly forecast price.




Fastmarkets forecasts also provide a commentary or summary which updates during the month giving a view of current factors impacting a price or group of prices.


To navigate from the Price Chart widget to the forecast commentary click on the Commentary menu at the top of the chart and select the symbol you wish to read a commentary for. If you



have multiple symbols in the chart those which have a forecast price will have a corresponding commentary available.



Fastmarkets commentary and market analysis provides in depth detail how the previous month's forecasts performed, what changed and why as well as intelligence and analysis from the latest industry events. This in depth market analysis can be found by navigating from the Price Chart widget or through the News List widget.






Preliminary Prices


The preliminary prices flag will now show against relevant prices on all the Dashboard widgets. In some markets, for example US scrap markets, Fastmarkets reserves the right to publish a preliminary price. These are determined using a combination of bid and offer information and transaction data for related commodities or grades. Preliminary prices are denoted with a [p] in the Dashboard. Where there are preliminary prices, you can use the toggle on the widget settings to choose whether to display them or not.







The preliminary price flag will also be displayed in Excel, when selecting to export static prices from the widget. Click on "Export options" and select "Export widget as – Microsoft Excel (.xlsx)" or "Copy values only" and paste into your Excel spreadsheet:



Where available, the preliminary price will be denoted with a [P]:




Recommended news lists


Recommended news lists are now available when setting up a news widget, making it easier to quickly find broad topics of news to add to Dashboard workspaces.

You can view news articles based on a specific search by using the search box, or select one of the recommended default news lists:





